

# Flash Talk Score Sheet: Earl Lewis Room

Moderators: Gary Sulikowski & Yamuna Krishnan

**Rules:** Each presenter is expected to give a concise and well-practiced introduction and a description of their research and/or future research interests, a **Flash Talk**. The moderator will stand at the 3 minute mark and the presenter should wrap-up in 15 seconds. If not, the moderator will terminate the presentation. Each presenter may only use 1 power point slide.

**Prizes:** There will be 2 prizes awarded for each room. One based upon the mentor score sheets and one upon the attendees score sheets.

**Instructions for Scoring:** Presentations are scored for each of the following categories.

- A. Engagement** (0-3 points): Did you want to learn more? Did the presenter convey enthusiasm? Did the speaker have sufficient stage presence, eye contact, and vocal range; maintain a steady pace?
- B. Comprehension** (0-3 points): Did you have a clear understanding of the subject? Did the presentation clearly describe the key points? Did the presenter avoid jargon, explain terminology?
- C. Content** (0-3 points): Was the talk in language appropriate to an intelligent person – but not a specialist in the field? Adequate time on each element? If used, did the PowerPoint slide(s) enhance the presentation?
- D. Creativity** (0-1 point): Did the presenter employ creative elements in the presentation?
